Derived from the dainty floral motifs which were popular in France in the mid-18th century, the design features small and beautifully colored blossoms arranged in a formal pattern.

Since its founding by a porcelain decorator in 1849, Uhlenhorst Porzellan has placed great importance on decorative design, maintaining a porcelain painting studio of superior quality. A staff of expert artists works under the guidance of Professor Alfred Mahlau, the firm's artistic director since 1958. The Hamburg-based porcelain house specializes in hand-colored motifs, including highly detailed city scenes and renderings of famous buildings.
