Nenthorn Studios thimbles (Scotland) 1985-1986

Nenthorn Studios were situated in the hamlet of Nenthorn, near Kelso, in the Scottish Borders. Their thimble production only lasted for a year. They were promoted by The Thimble Guild (TTG).

First issued in April 1985, finishing in April 1986.

The only additional information available is that the hand-thrown, glazed earthenware pottery thimbles were made by a pair of potters: the <u>Kerrs</u> – sometimes identified as a husband and wife team but only Nick Kerr is named. He probably was the pewterer, as I have seen his name associated with another Scottish thimble maker, John Urwin, who turned wooden thimbles. The toppers come in a variety of finishes – clever and playful creations.

It is rare to find pottery turned in miniature like some of the toppers.

The thimbles are of a sturdy pottery and unless indicated, they were made of a cobalt blue pottery with gilt lettering. There are no maker's marks on the thimbles. Nowhere in the catalogues are the toppers identified as made of pewter – rather just silver, copper or gold plated. They are mainly made of pewter. Some are of handpainted pewter. The bases or plinths that the object is placed on vary. Sometimes matching the theme.

On occasion the lettering is on both English and Gaelic – or just in Gaelic. Nick created several Scottish topics – probably only available from the specific site.

I have never featured thimbles with toppers before – it's my passion for Scottish-made thimbles that has led me to include this small output of thimbles.


