Thimbles with slogans

including thimbles with cryptic messages

I have always been fascinated with slogans, mementoes, inscriptions, mottos or keepsake messages on thimbles, with sayings using the language of love and chivalry or religious mottoes from the Middle Ages. (In a recent article in 2020 by Michel Painsonneau, he uses the term maxim for this type of thimble).

It was only when I acquired my first MIZPAH thimble, that I began to look at these thimbles where there is lettering around the rim. Mizpah is a Hebrew blessing "May the Lord watch between me and thee whilst we are absent one from another" (Genesis 31.v49)

Go back in time, when women were closely chaperoned, to the Victorian era and picture a young man in love. How was he to plead his love? A gift of a thimble with a word or phrase was not too personal and if it was accepted, he knew he could then pay suit. We get a glimpse of this bygone era and its manners with these themed thimbles. Some of these tokens of love were given when parting and there may be several sad stories attached to some of these messages.

By sheer serendipity when paging thru von Hoelle, on p296 I noticed his list of these inscriptions. So that's where this listing began. I then added those from Holmes on p180 and Zalkin p83-5. Di Pelham Burn produced a list of brass messages in the May 1999 issue of *At Your Fingertips*. With your help, I have now tracked over **205** different slogans or mottos on thimbles.

My perception of slogan thimbles was that they are Victorian and made of brass, with a few being made of silver. I now realise that they are made mainly of silver. The materials range from silver to tombac and brass - I have only seen two gold slogan thimbles. At the other end of the metal spectrum, I have come across a few of aluminium and one plastic slogan thimble; and most recently those of porcelain.

The earlier taller silver and brass or bronze thimbles from the era of James I (Jacobean) from the 1600s, bring messages from that time of chivalry and religious life – with obsolete spelling or lettering in Latin! They are distinctive for their strapwork designs, their messages on the 17th century thimbles have now passed into oblivion.

The slogan thimbles are mostly English and produced mainly in the Victorian era. French has always been associated with the language of love, so there is a small collection of French slogans, followed by those in German and Spanish, with one or two in Italian, Norwegian and Dutch. I have included slogans from all countries and all periods.

The only example I have not included is for 'Souvenir' which tho very prolific, doesn't have the romantic implications of this thematic topic.

The most popular slogan on thimbles is FORGET-ME-NOT: at February 2014 that numbers 55.

Many of the brass thimbles were made in late 19th C and probably made by Birmingham's Charles Iles

As most of the silver thimbles were made pre-1884, it is nearly impossible to know precisely when these thimbles were made or by whom they were made.

I have ignored all capital letters for the slogan - they are filed alphabetically by the first word of the slogan - even when this is the French word "Le ...", which is usually ignored in alphabetical listings.

The lettering is usually in upper case, plain letters, but Old English script was also quite popular.

I have also included the gold REGARD thimble - where six gemstones' first initial around the rim spells out the word REGARD. Recently another of this type emerged with DEAREST, created using seven stones.

Neither type need words.

With this topic already being a large one, I have not included many slogan thimbles from the late 20th century (ie the Franklin Mint set) nor those made in reproduction. These replica thimbles of the 20th century are made mainly of pewter, tho there are a few in silver, like those made in 1986 by Charterhouse Mint. Political and advertising slogans are also out of the scope of this topic.

In 1999, in the Museum of Sydney, Bridge Street, Sydney, there was a display of base metal and brass thimbles excavated from The Rocks area. I have noted those found with slogans, below.

On some of the early silver thimbles, from 17th century, the slogan is lettered upside-down. Was this so that the sewer could read the message whilst she stitched?

Three facets of Victorian life were FAITH - HOPE - CHARITY. This little boxed brass set of thimbles by Charles Iles, has a set of these values or slogans. Traditionally these also had symbols: faith by a cross - hope by an anchor - and charity by a heart.



I have come across two examples of slogan thimbles where a rebus image is used: where a pictogram is used instead of words.

See "Stick to me" and "Tho absent I..."!

Pictorial messages on 18th and 19th century thimbles

In 2022 I added this section: thimbles from 18th century that have pictorial messages punched or engraved around the band in the form pictures of everyday domestic objects.


One day the meaning of these messages will become apparent: so they are recorded here so that they aren't lost

I don't know a term for this group of thimbles so for now they are known as pictorial thimbles: not cryptic the word I was first using

These thimbles first came to our attention as thimble collectors in Brian Read's book which has hundreds of drawings of thimbles found in archaeological digs

Two of these interesting thimbles are illustrated (drawings 289-290)

They are all made of base metals, including bronze or a copper-alloy – a few additional examples have emerged





scissors - thimble - trellis - pincushion - woman - beaded cross found buried in Staffordshire



initial 'A' - trellis - two cups - two rackets or clubs (may even be spoons) - jug-like 'gin' bottle





this thimble almost doesn't fit as a pctorial - only the linking word ASH gives it a place



several linked elongated rondels - flower in eash - ASH



initial A - club - rose - cartouche - beehive - dog - fish
